

Dear EA Members:

On Thursday, January 13th, The Supreme Court voted in a 6-3 decision to block the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's Emergency Temporary Standard mandate for employers with 100 or more employees.

What does this mean for you? Although no longer mandated to enforce a vaccine and/or testing mandate, private employers can still decide to put their own vaccine/testing mandates in place.

SCOTUS did allow the CMS mandate for healthcare workers at Medicare and Medicaid-funded health facilities to remain in place.
